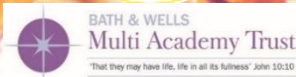




Court De Wyck Church School

Kingfisher Class

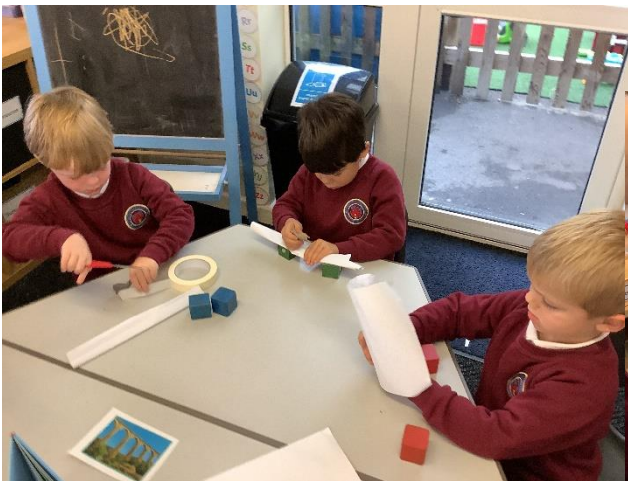
We had a great, yet disgusting, science experiment last week!

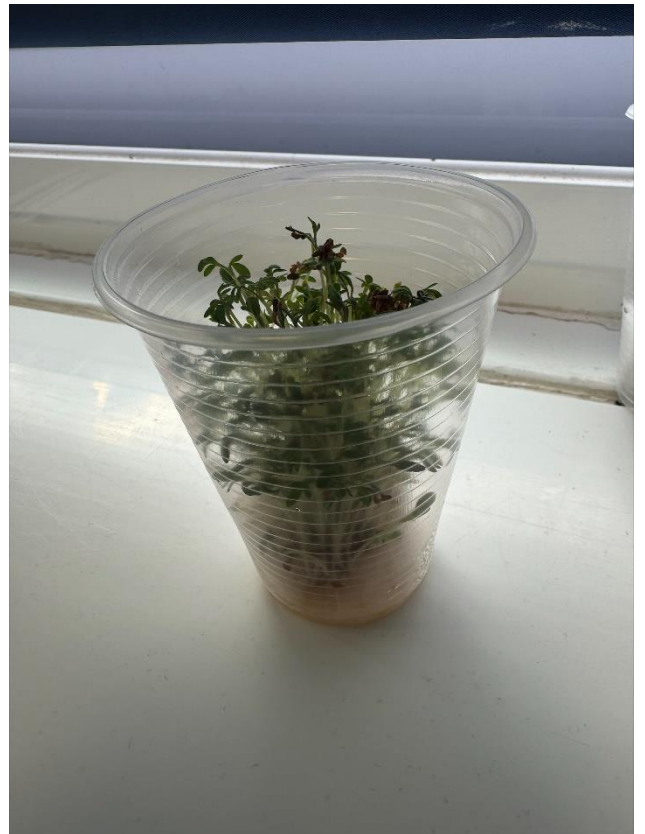
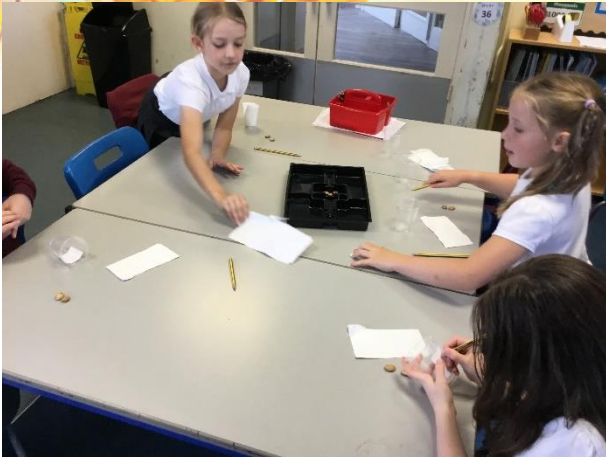
Robin Class
