A message from your Headteacher...

Dear families,

As we near the end of the year we look back on all the achievements of the year - and this year has been a great one for Court de Wyck. We have had numerous successes this year, from wonderful trips such as the pantomime, Bristol Zoo Project and Kilve Court to fund raising activities such as Elfridges and the Summer Fair, to curriculum developments and amazing learning experiences in school. We end the year with Y6 excelling themselves in the Y6 SATs. This week we received the results with CdW achieving a combined score (children achieving reading, writing and maths) of 72% (national average 61%) and 86% achieving maths (national average 73%), reading 81% (national average 74%), spelling and grammar 86% (national average 72%) and writing 82% (national average 72%). This really is something to be proud of! Huge congratulations to the Y6s and everyone involved in preparing the children – an amazing result yet again Court de Wyck!

The sound of 'Matilda' is filling the school at the moment as Y4-6 prepare for the end of year musical. Tickets are now on sale from the school office so get yours now – everyone is welcome. It's sure to be an evening to remember!

Next Wednesday is transition morning when children spend the morning with their teachers for next year. I am sure they will come home full of stories of what is happening! We also welcome our new Reception children in that morning - we look forward to seeing them all excited for the chance to visit their new setting!

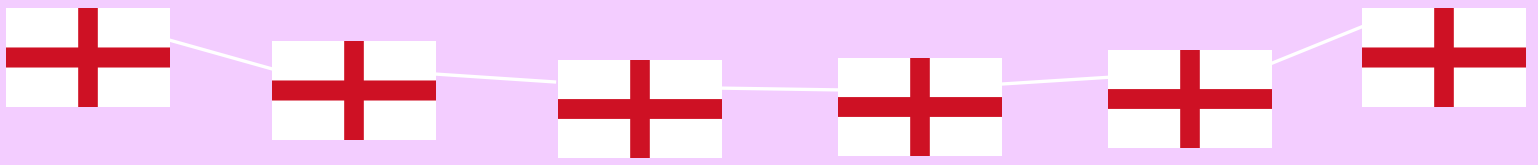

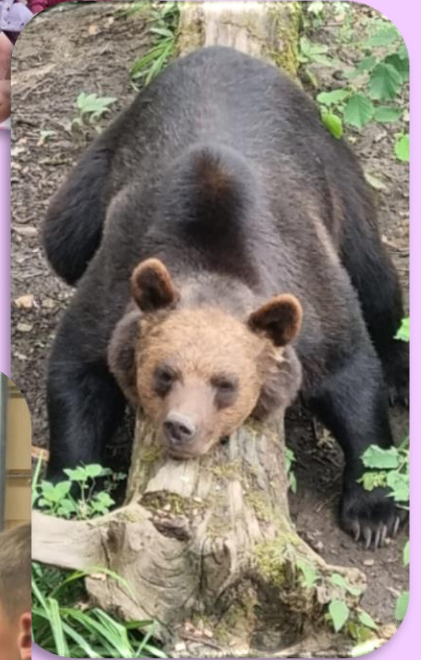
MAD SCIENCE AFTER SCHOOL CLUB
