wins and will be invited to have cake and squash with Mrs Baker-Brown.

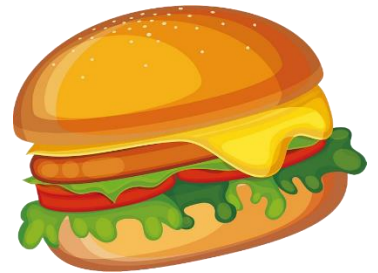
Dig deep and start collecting! Look under the sofa, in pockets, bags and in the car for those pesky coins and bring them into school!
