

## Fun ways to teach spelling.

1. Write each spelling word in white crayon, then colour over with a marker to watch them “magically” appear.
2. Write each spelling word across the rainbow. How many colours can you use?
3. Practice each word as you trace it with different writing tools.
4. Write words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and gluing them onto paper.
5. Use alphabet beads to make bracelets spelling the words, and then wear them all week. At the end of the week, take them apart and make new ones.
6. Roll play dough into “snakes” and spell out the words.
7. Use magnetic letters.
8. Go on a word hunt around the house – have a clipboard to write them as you find them.
9. Write the words in sand/shaving foam/glitter/flour.
10. Take In turn one letter at a time with an adult.
11. Make up a song.
12. Make up your own phenomics.
13. Write it in the air.
14. Look, copy, cover, write.
15. Spot the mistake.
