We are all really looking forward to meeting you and your siblings on the 25th November 1939. You will arrive at the Weston-super-Mare train station at about teatime. I think there will be many other children getting off the train at the same station, because Weston-Super-Mare is quite a big town. We are hoping to meet you there and then transport you by car to our village called Uphill. The village is small, friendly and close to the beach. Have you ever been to a beach? Everyone is extremely welcoming. We live on an old farm and we spend a lot of time playing and walking our dogs along the beach so we hope you will have fun. Do you have any pets? You will need to be wearing an ID label because we will need to identify you. You will also need your gas mask box although we are hoping you won't need to use it. The journey from London will take about 4 hours so we will make sure we have fresh milk, bread and cheese for you to eat and drink as soon as you arrive. We hope that you are not too nervous and will have a lovely stay with our family.
