

Spelling Lists
Term 3 2024

Each week, the spelling rule will be introduced on a Monday, consolidated throughout the week and tested on a Friday. For each rule, two lists have been provided with List B being more challenging than List A. Your child can choose each week which list to learn but should only learn List B if they are confident with all the spellings in List A. For each stage (Y1/2, Y3/4, Y5/6) there are also lists of words which do not fit a rule (known as common exception words) and there is a couple of these for your child to learn/revise.
