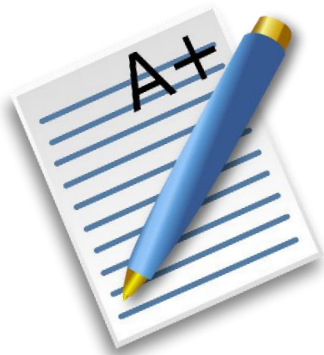

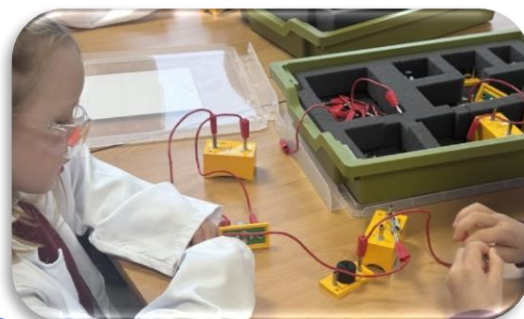
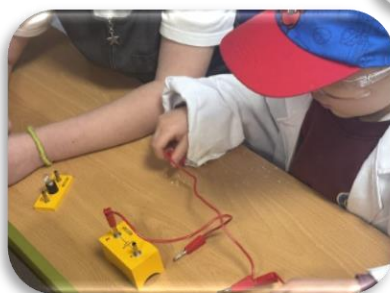
TT ROCKSTARS!
