Trainers are **not** to be worn to school, only for PE lessons.

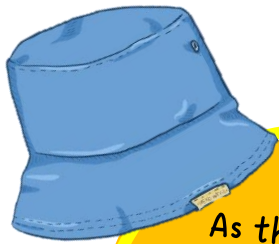
# FRIDGE FREEZER WANTED!
