ARBOR

We are no longer going to be sending out messages via text to parents as we will be charged for these. All messages usually received by text will now be sent on Arbor as an In-App message. Please ensure you have the Arbor app on your phone. If you do not have a log in, please contact the school office.

Most of you, if not all, should have the app already as this is where you select your childrens meals from. We have moved lunch selections to 24 hours' notice rather than the 3 days before. **Please remember, even if your child is a packed lunch must be selected on Arbor.**

ATTENDANCE

We would like to remind parents that school attendance is carefully monitored and is required to be reported to the Local Authority (North Somerset). Please be aware that unauthorised absences, including holidays taken during term time, are tracked cumulatively over a three-year period. In North Somerset, once a child has accumulated five days of unauthorised absence within this timeframe, the Local Authority has the authority to issue a fixed penalty notice. Currently, this is £60 per parent, per child, for each five-day period of absence if paid within the specified timeframe. If further unauthorised absences occur within the same three years, the fine increases to £120 per parent, per child. We kindly ask families to take this into consideration when planning time away from school, as regular attendance is vital for children's wellbeing, learning and progress.

Don't forget, Kestrel and Kingfisher parents you have 1 week for priority tickets when they go on sale on Monday 29th before they then go on general sale to the rest of the school on Monday 6th July.
